

SEAT ALLOCATION for 5-year Integrated Law Degree Course/s and LL.M.

UG Courses (5-year Integrated Law Degree Course/s)

IIULER proposes to reserve 52 seats as per the following categories: -

- 12 seats will be for candidates from SAARC countries,
- 12 seats shall be for non-SAARC countries,
- 12 seats shall be for NRIs/Overseas Citizen of India/person of Indian origin or candidates sponsored by NRI's.
- 6 seats shall be for nominees of Government of India and
- 10 seats shall be for citizens/students of those foreign countries who enter into an MoU either with Bar Council of India or the Government of India to allow Indian students to practice and/or to establish law firms in their own jurisdictions on the basis of reciprocity.

Thereafter, out of remaining seats, there shall be 20% reservation for Goan students.

Thereafter, 15% seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Castes and there shall be 7.5% seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes.

This apart 10% seats will be for Economically Weaker Sections Quota (E.W.S. Quota) (Over & above the sanctioned strength of seats)

There shall be a Separate Cell/Unit for welfare of International Students.

P.G. courses (LL.M.)

20% seats will be for Foreign Nationals;

10% for N.R.Is

2 seats for Government nominees

Thereafter, 20 % reservation shall be for Goan students.

Thereafter, 15% seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Castes and there shall be 7.5% seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes

Note:-

(a) Only Indian students shall be required to appear at India International University Legal Education Test (IIULET).

(b) N.R.Is and Foreign students shall not be required to appear in the entrance examination for UG & PG courses. However, students of all categories shall be required to pay the Registration Fee and get themselves registered through website of IIULER.

(c) If deserving candidates are not found for the 52 seats in the categories referred above, they shall be filled by deserving candidates from General category.

There shall be no reservation of any category for Research scholars.
